



Appearance Industries Code of Practice Summary

Part 1: Premises

Minimum Standards 1B: Mobile or Temporary Premise. All operators must comply with section 1A or 1B.

Fit for purpose: Your premise needs to be designed, constructed, and arranged so as to be fit for its purpose.

Repairs and cleanliness: Keep the premises and all fittings, fixtures, and appliances in working order and in a clean and tidy condition.

- Don't let rubbish pile up.
- Make structural repairs, renovations, plumbing, or drainage quickly if necessary.

Walls, floors, ceilings, fixtures, and fittings: Make sure these can be easily cleaned and in good order. If walls are likely to get splashed, they must be made of a waterproof material.

Lighting: The lighting must be bright enough for cleaning and inspection:

- At least 100 lux at a point 800mm above the floor, in every part of shop.
- At least 300 lux at all working surfaces where you attend customers and clean instruments.
- Lighting should be free from glare and shouldn't create shadows.

Ventilation: Your premise should have good ventilation.

Mattresses, squabs, and cushion covers: These must be covered with a waterproof and easily cleanable cover.

Storage of linen and other supplies: Safely store all clean and used equipment, linen, and waste products in separate containers before and after use and while in transit.

Cleanliness: You must have a clean work area at the site of service. Keep this area clean. Only use sterile or single use disposable instruments for piercing the skin.

Hand-washing facilities: You must have access to a hand washing area with hot and cold running water, soap and a single use paper towel or hand dryer.
