We refer to your official information request dated 21 April 2021:

Please can you provide me with the full hunting data for the wild animal control hunting operation that was recently carried out in the Hayward reserve area between the top of Wainui hill and Naenae. Please include geospatial data of hunters gps track logs, animal kill locations, species, M/F etc etc. Thank you for your assistance.

We do not have hunters GPS track logs, so we are declining this part of your request under section 17(g) of the Local Government Official Information and Meetings Act. We have provided you with the remaining information you have requested.

Only two animals were removed from the area in question. Both were in the same location, and both female red deer (*Cervus elaphus*).
