LGOIMA request for information about Mayor Barry's personal donations

On behalf of the Mayor, I refer to your request dated 14 May 2021 for a list of Mayor Barry's personal donations for the past financial year, in relation to his voluntary 10 per cent pay reduction announced on 16 April 2020.

To give effect to this voluntary pay reduction, the Mayor committed to donating an amount equivalent to 10 per cent of his salary to local community groups and charities. You have requested the amounts of these donations, the groups who received the donations, and the date they were made.

I have provided the requested information below and overleaf.

The Mayor has donated an amount equivalent to 10 per cent of his net salary, calculated to be \$10,072.00. In using the net figure, the Mayor has not claimed a tax refund against this charitable giving, nor does he have any plans to.

In his announcement, the Mayor committed to donating the amount over "the next 12 months" through to 16 April 2021. In practice, the Mayor set aside the required funds, however not all of this was paid during the 12-month period for various reasons - including delays in invoicing and delays in payment.
