- 1. How many redundancy payments have been made by Hutt City Council?
 - a. What is the total value of these redundancy payments

Answer: 10 redundancy payments have been made; the approximate value is \$350k

2. How many redundancy payments have been made to staff that have since been rehired by the Council?

Answer: No one who has been made redundant has been rehired.

a. What is the total value of these redundancy payments?

Answer: Nil

3. How many of these redundancy payments were made to members of the IT, GIS, and Apps teams respectively?

Answer: 1

4. How many long service payments have been made by the Council?

Answer: 5

a. What is the total value of these long service payments?

Answer: Approximately \$5000

5. What is the total number of staff who have been made redundant, resigned, given notice, or otherwise been dismissed by the Council?

Answer: Excluding fixed term and casual staff.
