Thank you for your enquiry to Hutt City Council regarding why the roundabout a Williams/Heretaunga St is being resurfaced

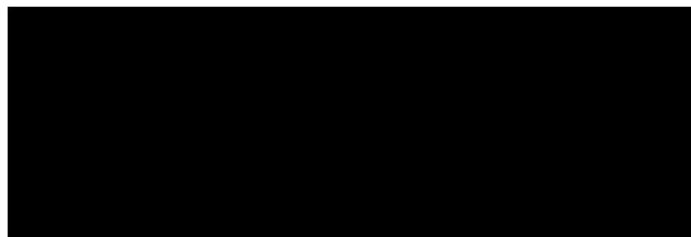
The roundabout currently has multiple pavement failures and the surfacing is aged and oxidised.
