Hutt City Council has made decisions on provisions and matters raised in the submissions to

Proposed District Plan Change 52: Alignment of the District Plan with the New Zealand Heritage List

Proposed District Plan Change 52 seeks to seeks to amend the District Plan to ensure that all buildings and structures in the district that are listed, or are nominated and anticipated to be listed, in the New Zealand Heritage List are identified and protected through the existing objectives, policies and rules of the District Plan.

The Proposed Plan Change also updates terms used in *Chapter 14F: Heritage Buildings and Structures* of the District Plan to reflect changes to legislation.

Notice of the decisions is given under Clauses 10 and 11 of the First Schedule of the Resource Management Act 1991.

Such appeals must be in the prescribed form and lodged with the Environment Court within 30 working days of service of the Council's decision in accordance with Clause 14 of the First Schedule of the Resource Management Act 1991.
