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Preamble and History

We were asked by the Hutt city Council to test The Hardwick-Smith Lounge for Mould.

I undertook 5 Air samples using our Buck Bioslide Machine set at 15 Litres of Air Per Minute.

1 sample was Taken Outside as a comparison.

I in the Kitchen

1 in the Centre of the Hall

1 in the Toilet Area and

1 in the small lounge where the Chairs are stored.(near the Front door)

We found considerable moisture issues throughout the building, with Gib disintegrating and obvious Mold Contamination with discoloration and odour

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Remediation Suggestions

There is a serious Issue with Toxic Mould here in this building.

There is also the strong possibility that there is Gram-Negative Bacteria in the Carpet, it is my recommendation that the Carpet tiles and Carpet are also removed from all rooms.

It would be my recommendation that the building be "closed" until remediation has taken place. (Strip out of Mouldy Material and rotten Timber and Gib)

Please find Biodet Services report.

Any work undertaken for remediation is to be to the IICRC S500 & S520 Standard

It is also my suggestion that the remediators are familiar with dealing with toxic mould. Full PPE and RPE should be used and personnel should be suitably qualified. (I am happy to ensure this takes place if requested)

I have used Barry Timms from Chemdry on many occasions and have found his work is excellent. His phone number is 02149155

Further Air testing needs to be undertaken before rebuilding takes place to prevent any Viable spores colonizing again, if the right conditions are present.

I WOULD INITIALLY SUGGEST AN AIR SCRUBBER AND A COMMERCIAL DEHUMIDIFIER BE INSTALLED TO DRY THE AIR AND REMOVE TOXIC MOULD SPORES FROM THE ENVIROMENT.
