Alcohol Fees Bylaw	The purpose of this bylaw is to prescribe fees for all matters for which fees payable to territorial authorities are prescribed in the Sale and Supply of Alcohol (Fees) Regulations 2013.	17-Sep-19
Appearance Industries Bylaw	The purpose of this bylaw is to promote and protect public health by requiring certain services to comply with minimum standards and requiring a licence for certain services.	29-Sep-20
Cemeteries Bylaw	The purpose of this bylaw is to enable the Council to control and set standards for the operation of cemeteries within Lower Hutt and under the Council's ownership.	12-Dec-17
Control of Alcohol in Public Places	This bylaw protects public safety by enabling alcohol bans in public places that experience high levels of alcohol-related crime or disorder.	15-Dec-16
Control of Animals Bylaw	This bylaw promotes responsible animal ownership and interactions such as noise and animal wellbeing. It includes rules about animals in public places.	11-Dec-18
Dog Control Bylaw	This bylaw regulates public places where dogs can be taken and where they are prohibited; licensing obligations; limitations of dogs per household; exceptions for working dogs; dog wellbeing; and impounding of dogs.	15-Dec-15

<p>Solid Waste Management and Minimisation</p>	<p>The purpose of this bylaw is to support the promotion and delivery of effective and efficient waste management and minimisation, implementation of the Wellington Region Waste Management and Minimisation Plan; regulation of waste collection, transport and disposal including recycling, waste storage and management; controls around the responsibilities of customers who use approved solid waste services and the licensing of waste collectors and waste operators; protection of the health and safety of waste collectors, waste operators and the public; management of litter and nuisance relating to waste in public places.</p>	<p>25-Jan-21</p>
<p>Speed Limits Bylaw (Note that this will not be renewed. The responsibilities currently under this bylaw are being transferred to national level)</p>	<p>This bylaw allows Council to designate urban traffic areas and to set and amend speed limits by resolution for the Lower Hutt City area, on all roads under its jurisdiction and in certain designated locations.</p>	<p>28-Jul-15</p>
<p>Hutt Valley Trade Wastes Bylaw</p>	<p>The purpose of this bylaw is to control trade waste discharges into the wastewater system to protect the wastewater system; promote cleaner production; protect the stormwater system; protect workers operating in or with the wastewater system; protect the environment; and to provide a basis for consenting and monitoring discharges from industry and trade premises; charging trade waste users of the wastewater system to cover the cost of conveying, treating and disposing of or reusing their wastes; and to ensure that the costs of treatment and disposal are shared fairly between trade waste and domestic wastewater discharges.</p>	<p>21-Sep-16</p>

Parks and Reserves Bylaw	The purpose of this bylaw is to regulate and enforce rules around access to council owned parks and reserves; prohibited and restricted activities in reserves; organised events in reserves; offences and exemptions.	12-Dec-17
Prevention of Nuisance from fire and smoke	The purpose of this bylaw is to protect the public from nuisance related to fires and smoke and to protect and maintain public health and safety around fire and smoke (with regard to aspects other than fire safety).	11-Dec-18
Public Places Bylaw	This bylaw supports LH residents to enjoy public places through rules around behaviour in public places; restricted activities in public places; naming of streets and numbering of buildings; noise, display and advertising, congregations and processions; street collections; cattle and sheep in public places; building and building features; encroachments; street musicians; street stalls; offences and penalties.	20-Sep-16
Trading in Public Places	This bylaw outlines restrictions on hawking, mobile shops and stalls, and council permits.	13-Mar-18
Traffic Bylaw	This bylaw includes rules about parking, restrictions on activities that can take place on a road, skateboarding, driving and parking restrictions on beaches, fees and offences.	12-Dec-17
Water Supply Bylaw (Note that this bylaw will not be renewed. The responsibilities under this bylaw will be transferred to the new water service entities)	The purpose of this bylaw is to outline allowed and prohibited activities to protect the water supply.	2-Aug-22
