Kia ora,

City Centre: Proposed off-street paid parking sites

Hutt City Council is proposing two new temporary off-street paid parking sites – Daly Street North and High Street South.

These sites have been identified as suitable locations for additional temporary parking areas in the city centre during works for Te Wai Takamori o Te Awa Kairangi (RiverLink) and once the Riverside Car Park closes.

These temporary parking spaces will ensure fair access to all-day parking options within walking distance of the city centre while essential Te Awa Kairangi works continue.

What we are proposing

We are proposing two new off-street paid parking sites at Daly Street North (6-12 Daly Street) and High Street South (69-95 High Street), delivered in a staged approach.

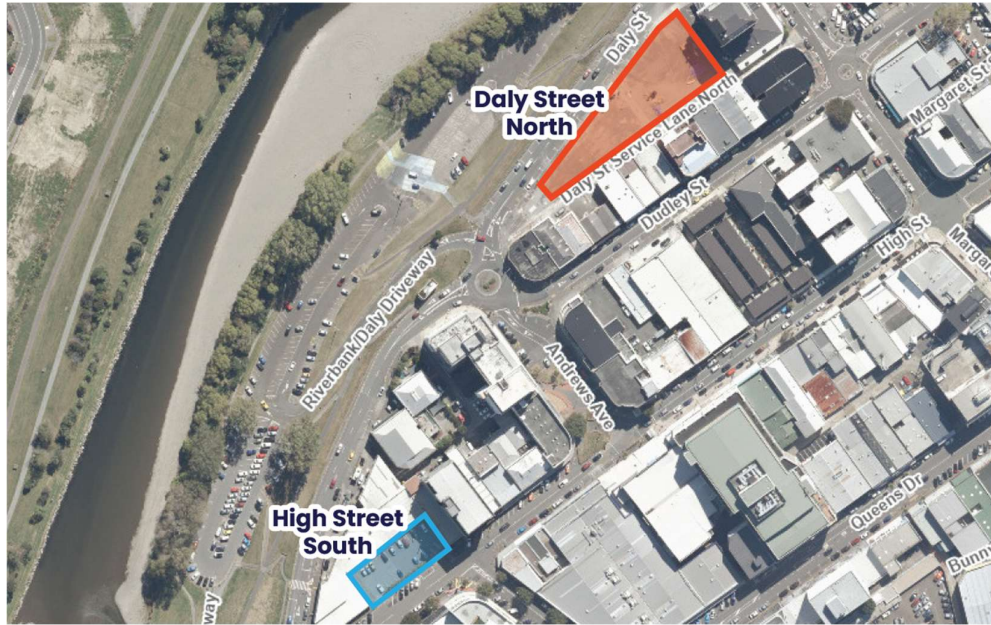
Daly Street North:

- Stage 1 will add 42 new marked parking spaces, including one mobility parking space, with vehicle access from Daly Street and pedestrian access from Dudley Street via a laneway. Figure 1 is overleaf.
- Stage 1 is expected to be in place from July 2026.
- Stage 2 would provide an additional 42 marked parking spaces, including two mobility parking spaces. The entrance would move further south along Daly Street, which would require the removal of five on-street parking spaces. Figure 2 is overleaf.
- Stage 2 is expected to be in place before the Riverbank Car Park closes.
- The site would operate as HC3 parking (\$3/hour or \$12/day).

High Street South:

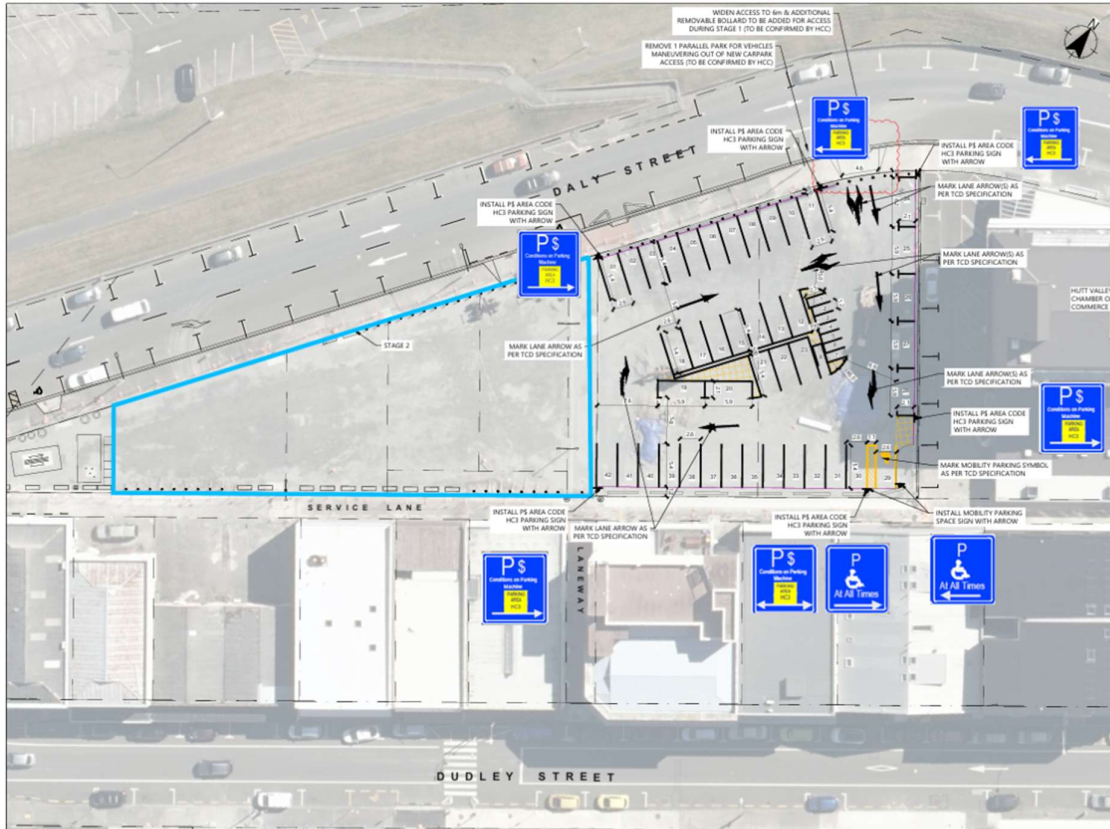


Fig 3. High Street South – Stage 1: existing car park

- Stage 1 reflects the existing car park layout with 32 parking spaces and vehicle access from High Street – Figure 3 is over leaf.
- Stage 1 parking changes are expected to be in place later in 2026, subject to Greater Wellington Regional Council neighbouring demolition and construction works.

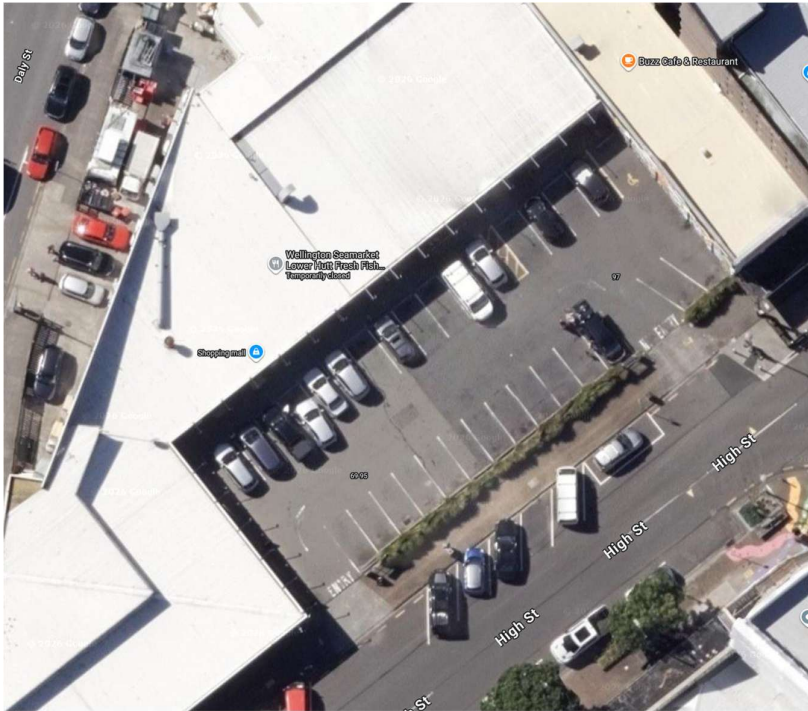


Fig 4. High Street South – Stage 2

- Stage 2 is planned for end of 2026 or early 2027 as we accommodate demolition and construction works. Figure 4 is overleaf.
- The site would operate as HC3 parking (\$3/hour or \$12/day).
