This is an application by Kenshi Okada for a manager's certificate.

The application was duly notified and no opposition or notice of desire to be heard has been received. Accordingly I deal with the matter on the papers.

Pursuant to the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012, the application by Kenshi Okada for a manager's certificate is **granted**.

I am satisfied as to the matters to which we must have regard as set out in s.217 of the Act.

STATUTORY CRITERIA

Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012

217 Manager's certificate

- A manager's certificate authorises the holder to manage any licensed premises.

REASONS FOR THE DECISION

I have considered this application on the basis of the reports received from Police and an Inspector appointed under the Act who do not oppose the issue of the application. In addition no objections have been raised.

DECISION

The District Licensing Committee Chair, acting pursuant to the Sale and Supply Of Alcohol Act 2012 **grants** an application by Kenshi Okada for a manager's certificate.

The holder of this manager's certificate has provided an undertaking agreeing that he will limit the use of this managers certificate to the premises located at Level 1/215 High Street, Lower Hutt trading as Neko Ngeru Cate Café.

The Chair notes that the premises was still under construction at the time of this decision, the On-License that was applied for alongside your Managers certificate will not be issued until the Secretary of the District Licensing Committee has been supplied with a copy of the Code Compliance Certificate (CCC) or Certificate of Public Use (CPU), together with confirmation from the Licensing Inspector that the premises have been inspected and approved by them.
