Application 48/CERT/0132/25 for a new Manager's Certificate under section 219 of the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act – Colin Paul Barnden

Colin Paul Barnden of 94 Stokes Valley Road, Stokes Valley, Lower Hutt has applied for a Manager's Certificate in accordance with section 219 of the Act. The applicant has a birthdate of 2 October 1960 and is currently 65 years of age.

Colin, the club Vice President, is intending to be a manager at Stokes Valley Bowling Club at 50 Horoeka Street, Stokes Valley where he has been a club member for 8 years and club Vice President for 1 year.

Colin was interviewed at the Hutt City Council office on 20 January 2025 and he demonstrated a good understanding of the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012, host responsibility and the licence conditions for the premises that he intends to use the Manager's Certificate, if granted.

The applicant has had 2 years experience in the sale of alcohol including supervisory duties assisting with bar duty at Stokes Valley Bowling Club.

Colin has supplied a copy of his Licence Controller Qualification (LCQ) Certificate, a letter confirming he is a current club member as well as Vice President and a character reference which describes the applicant as honest, responsible and highly reliable.

Taking the above into account Colin should be familiar with the responsibilities of a manager under the Act.

A copy of the application was sent to Police on 3 December 2025. Police responded stating they have no matters of opposition to the granting of a Managers Certificate for this applicant.

As far as I am aware Colin is a suitable person to hold a Manager's Certificate.

Having regard to the information supporting this application I recommend that the Manager's Certificate for Colin Paul Barnden be granted and forward this report to the DLC for its decision.
