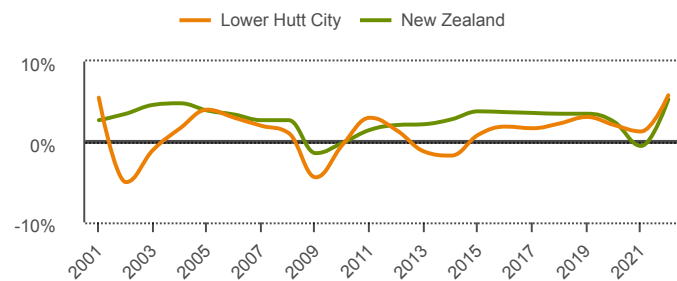

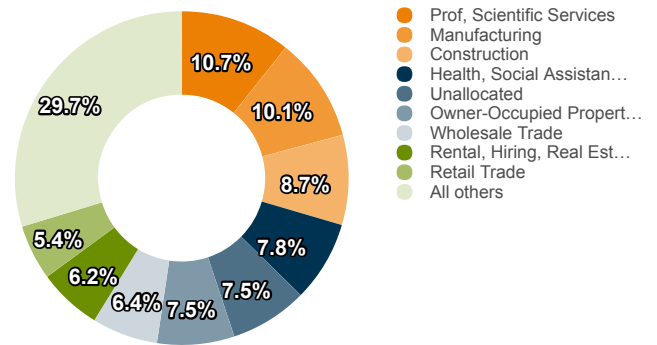

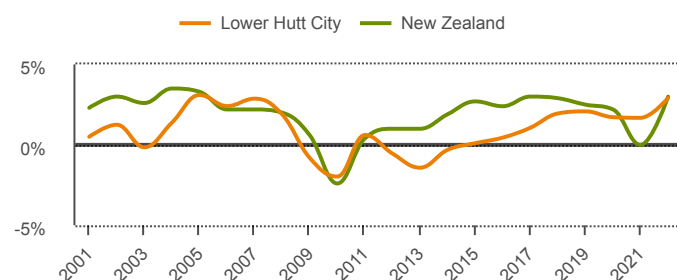

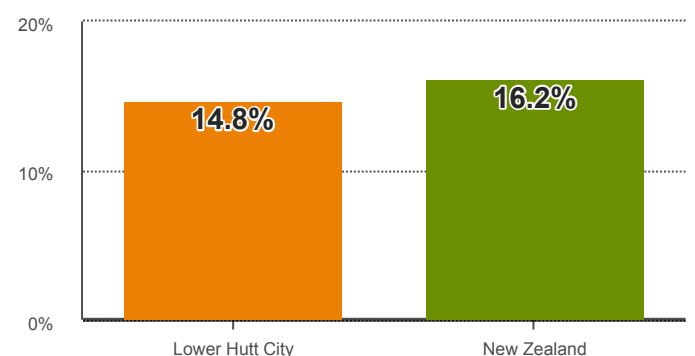
Employment growth, 2001-2022

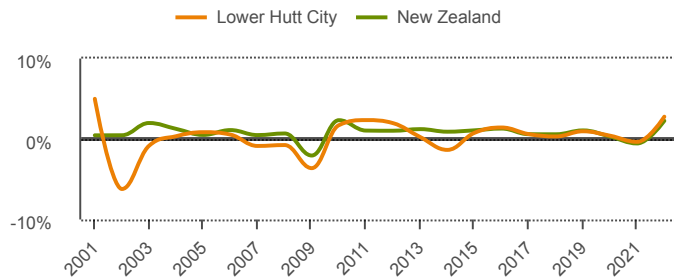

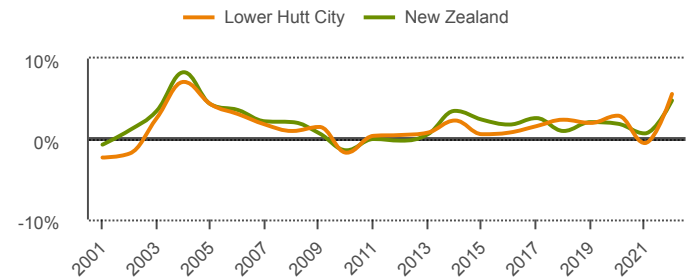

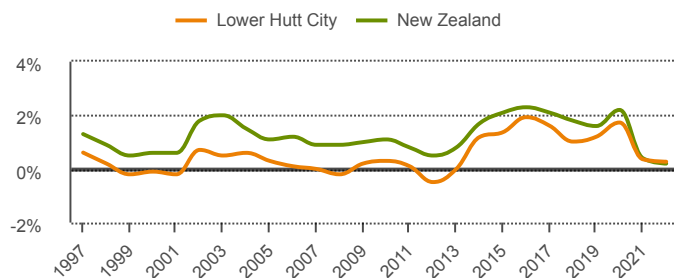
