# Key Election Dates - 2025

- •30 June Candidates Briefing
- •4 July Nominations Open
- •11 July Formal pre-election period starts
- August Nominations close (noon)
- •9 September Voting period begins
- •11 October Voting closes (noon)
- •11 October Preliminary Results
- •15-18 October Final results declared



Clearly and transparently differentiate between activities conducted as an incumbent elected member and activities conducted while campaigning for re-election.



Resources owned by the Council and made available to you should only be used for Council purposes.



Council-run social media accounts are considered Council resources and must remain politically neutral during the election. You must comply with our social media guidelines for candidates at all times.



You will continue to have access to the information you need to do your job as an incumbent.

Council officers will not provide assistance with electioneering activities.



Council resources provided for mayoral use should not be used for any electioneering activities associated with any candidate.



## **Relevance of Protocols**

These guidelines are always applicable but are especially relevant in the three months leading up to the election. It is your responsibility to ensure your

behaviour aligns with these guidelines and the Council's Code of Conduct.
