## Introduction

8. We strongly oppose the application of the proposed **high natural hazard area** to the area we live in – the Petone Beach Precinct area. Specifically the application of a 'High Tsunami Hazard', a 'High/ Medium Flood Hazard' and a 'Medium Coastal Inundation Hazard' overlays on our property at 6A Oriental St, Petone.

Our property has not been flooded, nor affected by Coastal Inundation or ever been hit by a Tsunami. Please can your reconsider your application of these areas to be only at The Esplanade, Petone (on the beach) and not in the area of housing that makes up the Petone Beach Precinct area. We believe housing away from The Esplanade, Petone is not at risk. We have serious concerns on the affect this may have on our property from the application of these high natural hazard areas — namely ability to improve/ modify our property, resale value, insurance cover and Earthquake Commission future cover.
