				the lots contain steep slopes and are covered	
				in high levels of vegetation, which simply are	
				not suitable for development at the scale	
				permitted by the rezoning to Medium Density	
				Residential. Rezoning will also place additional	
				pressure on infrastructure that is already	
				constrained, with access limited to a single	
				road in and out, limited public transport and	
				degraded wastewater services with raw	
				wastewater evident in the local stream after	
				rain events.
