Specifically, WSP states that the maps should not be used at a scale greater than 1:2,000 or for site specific assessments. This is due to no site-specific data or analysis being incorporated into the development of the Slope Hazard overlay or into the development of any of the GIS input layers.	Council should reconsider the use of these maps being used for site specific assessments given the limitations in the technical reports.

They note that if these maps are to be
used at a scale of more than 1:2,000
or for site specific assessments a
disclaimer should be included.
As it is now and another disput both City
As it is my understanding Hutt City
Council are proposing to use the maps
for site specific assessments this may
have perverse outcomes for property
owners such as increased insurance
costs and therefore any limitations
should be made clear or addressed.
I would also like to bring attention to
the point that WSP raise that the
slope hazard overlay is an only an
indicator of where higher levels of
slope hazards are present and does
not indicate that there are no slope
hazards outside the slope hazard
overlay. This highlights the
inaccuracies of the overlay and the
would-be arbitrary nature of it being
used on a site-by-site basis.
