Relief Sought in Evidence Not Addressed in the Section 42A Rebuttal Evidence

As requested by the Commissioner, the following provides a summary of the relief sought in my evidence that was not addressed in the section 42A rebuttal evidence. I continue to rely on and support the conclusions and recommendations set out in my evidence in relation to these matters.

- Delete the word ‘structures’ from the Liquefaction Hazard Overlay rules (NH-R15, NH-R16, NH-R17).
- Amend the planning maps and / or Fault Location Area provisions to clearly identify the location of the Uncertain/Constrained, Uncertain/Poorly Constrained, and Well Defined Extension Areas.
- Insert corresponding explanatory notes beneath the underlying natural hazards rules in the Flood Hazard Overlay and Coastal Hazard Overlay provisions to identify where the Regionally Significant Coastal Business Areas Overlay take precedence.
