
Overview

- Current problem: Heavy traffic on narrow local streets outside 3x schools, unsafe to walk/cycle to school
- Opportunity: Safety improvements and mode shift
- Speed bumps, intersection narrowing, chicanes, removing on-street parking





Site plan






Timeline

- October: Community engagement, analysis and where necessary change plans, check cost estimates.
- November: Traffic Subcommittee to approve option for construction
- January: Construction
- **February April**: Public engagement
- May: Present to traffic subcommittee



What the community said



- Full support x59
- Full opposition x14
- Opposition to specifically intersection narrowing x12

- "Removing more car parks is a good thing"
- "The streets are too cramped to ride bikes on, these changes will fix it"
- "Leaving home at 2-2.30pm is difficult. They are elderly so accessibility for elderly is important to them."




Community engagement

- Letter drop + Facebook + webpage
- Receiving emails (13)
- Door knocking (57)
- Intercept survey (24)
- School Principal interview (3)
- 46% of emails received were oppositional, whereas only 10% of door knocking interactions had oppositional views. Door knocking had 63% supportive views of the plans.



Impact on the design

- Checking turning at intersection narrowing
- Yellow no parking lines versus blue no parking at peak times






Trial period 10-17 May 2023
