Request for Information – Local Government Official Information and Meetings Act (LGOIMA) 1987

We refer to your official information request dated 18 December 2025, seeking information about the ownership and classification of reserve land between the Marae and Bryan Morgan Terrace housing in Wainuiomata. Specifically, you requested:

“Does this reserve land belong to:

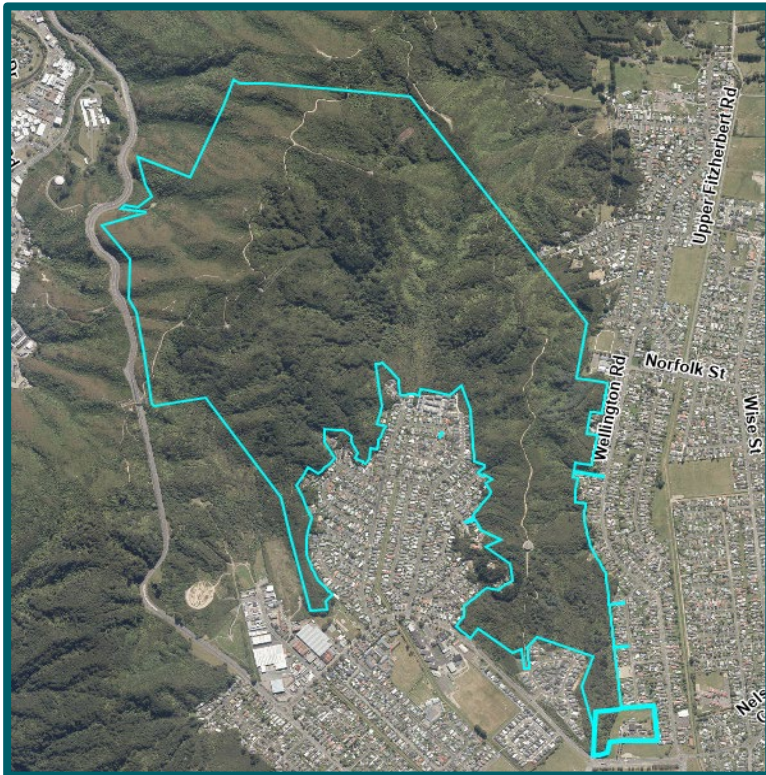
- *Hutt City Council?*
- *Greater Wellington Regional Council?*
- *Is this Parks & Reserves?”*

Answer:

The land located between the Wainuiomata Marae and the housing on Bryan Morgan Terrace is recorded as 85 Parkway. It is approximately 228 hectares in size and is owned by Hutt City Council. It is not owned or managed by Greater Wellington Regional Council.

This land is known as Parkway Bush and has been formally gazetted as a Scenic Reserve under the Reserves Act 1977. Although the reserve includes a public track, it is not subject to any specific maintenance work under Council’s parks maintenance contracts.

For ease of reference, the aerial map below shows the boundary of 85 Parkway outlined in blue. This is the full extent of the reserve land situated between the Marae and the adjoining residential areas:
