Request for Information – Local Government Official Information and Meetings Act (the Act) 1987

We refer to your request of 27 April 2024 for:

Could you please provide me with all records you hold regarding any work undertaken on Hair Street, Wainuiomata between 1 January 2003 and 31 December 2012.

Response:

The nature of your request is very broad.

“All works” is very broad and you have clarified that you intend for this to be a catch all. This would include engineering work, transport considerations, vegetation work, building and resource consents, electrical work, and a wide variety of other potential work.

“Everything on/ to do with Hair Street” is also very broad and could include the road reserve (as in the public roadway and foot path) along with the roughly 138 houses along the street.

You have asked for the time frame of 9 years which is a significant period and many works across those 138 properties can happen within a 9-year period.

To capture all the information within the scope of your request would spread across multiple government organisations, teams within those organisations, and data bases. Further, the information is not readily available in an easily collated format. As the request stands, we estimate that it would take many months to collate this information.



Therefore, we are refusing your request under section 17(f) of the Act, as that the information requested cannot be made available without substantial collation or research.
