**Request for Information – Local Government Official Information and Meetings Act (LGOIMA) 1987**

We refer to your official information request dated 7 April 2022 relating to use of the Waterloo to Taita cycleway. This is known as the Beltway Cycleway.

Cyclist counts on this cycleway, for the most recent data available (01 January 2022 to 10 April 2022), are below:

The number of cyclists has increased due to the improved cycle infrastructure created by the Beltway Cycleway. Prior to the construction of the Beltway, the detailed cyclist count survey undertaken by Hutt City Council recorded an average of approximately 32 cyclists per day for Oxford Terrace and Cambridge Terrace.
