# Request for Information – Local Government Official Information and Meetings Act 1987

We refer to your official information request dated 7 December 2023 for information regarding the following:

- End-of-year staff bonuses from years 2022 and 2023
- Christmas festivity and regalia costs from years 2022 and 2023

- Senior staff holiday leave
- Contractors pay affected over the Christmas period.
- Intended fine increases for offences over the Christmas period.

#### **End-of-Year Bonuses:**

- No (\$0) end-of-year bonuses were paid to the CEO this Christmas.
- No (\$0) bonuses were paid to staff employed by Hutt City Council this Christmas.

### **Christmas Parties:**

• Not applicable/no (\$0) was spent on Council Christmas parties in 2022 and 2023. There were no (\$0) travel arrangement costs in 2022 and 2023.

### Office Closure:

- Duration of office closure during the Christmas period: For 2023/24 HCC closedown was from Sunday 24 December 2023, up to and including Tuesday 2 January 2024. Note this does not apply to staff who work front of house in our facilities that remain open (pools, museums and x3 hubs/libraries), or essential services e.g., animal control.
- Staff at all levels are encouraged to take additional leave over this period. To
  respond to this question, we will require clarification ie, are we talking tier 2
  and 3 leaders, and would 'blanket' mean those taking more than just the days
  covered by the closedown?
- Yes, the closedown also applied to contractors.

#### Fines:

• No, the council have no plans to increase fines for parking offences or any other offences during the Christmas period.
