## Request for Information – Local Government Official Information and Meetings Act 1987 (LGOIMA)

We refer to your official information request dated 22 May 2023, in which you have asked about progress on a number of Hutt City Council projects.

The information you have requested is provided in brief below.

## Gravity main, pump station & rising main, Ewen Bridge to Railway Avenue, Lower Hutt

- Is the funding submitted to Infrastructure Acceleration Fund (IAF) approved?
- Is the site investigation completed?
- Is the concept plans completed?
- Are you currently doing sketch plans?

Funding is approved for this project. Site investigation is not yet underway but is being planned. Early stage concept plans are complete.

Appropriate drawings will be done in due course.

## Wainuiomata Sportsville Hub project

- Is this project still on hold?
- Has it been abandoned?
- What is the current status of the project

The Wainuiomata Sportsville Hub is not currently a live project and is not being progressed currently.

## Toilet block refurbishment project at Point Howard, Lower Hutt

- Is this project still on hold?
- Has it been abandoned?
- What is the current status of the project

This work may be undertaken in 2023/24 but this is not certain at this time.

Riverlink Commercial buildings demolition & asbestos removal project at 6-7 & 10 Daly Street

- Has the contract been awarded? If yes, may I ask who is the winner?
- Has construction started? If yes, when did it start?
- When is construction expected to be completed?

This contract has not been formally awarded yet. The demolition work has not yet started but it is expected to be completed in 2023.
