Request for Information – Local Government Official Information and Meetings Act (the Act) 1987

We refer to your request of 28 April 2024 for:

I want to know how many dog attacks have been reported to HCC by suburb since 2018, by year.

For dog attacks reported to HCC since 2018, by year, in Wainuiomata;

- what has been the outcome of the complaint (# number by closure reason)

- how many attacks involved the death of the victim animal

- what, if any, restitution has been received by complainants or victims
- how many attacks had humans as a direct victim (bite, etc)

Please provide the HCC policy and process for investigating dog attack complaints, and what the thresholds are for escalation.
