Request for Information – Local Government Official Information and Meetings Act (LGOIMA) 1987

We refer to your official information request dated 14 July 2022 for:

“...information sent by Council to Stuff and/or Matt Tso relating to Councillor attendance at Briefings/Meetings and any correspondence between the Council and Matt Tso/Stuff relating in any way to the same. This request relates to information sent and correspondence had within the last calendar month..”.
