- Does Council have a zero tolerance policy to graffiti? Yes
- 2. Does council have specific areas set aside for graffiti to be undertaken? No, not at all
- 3. How does Council handle the removal of graffiti (contractor or staff)? Contractor
- 4. How much does Council spend a year on graffiti removal? Approx \$190,000
- Does (or has) council prosecute(d) taggers?
 No, Council does not have the power to prosecute for tagging. This lies with the Police.
- 6. Does Council proactively seek out graffiti or does it wait for it to be reported? Both, 95% is proactive
- 7. Does Council clean non council assets?
 Yes, when road facing or offensive on private property
- 8. If contracted, when is this up for renewal? June 2023
- Has Council implemented any projects that has reduced the amount of graffiti in their area?
 Mural Projects around the city
- 10. Does Council participate in the Graffiti Forum? Yes
