Request for Information – Local Government Official Information and Meetings Act (LGOIMA) 1987

We refer to your official information request dated 5 March 2026, seeking information on rates for Jackson Street and parking revenue for Jackson Street and the Peel Street Car Park. Specifically, you requested:

- a. *Total annual Hutt City Council rates for Jackson Street from Cuba Street to Hutt Road.*
- b. *Parking meter revenue for Jackson Street and Peel Street Car Park from 1 October 2025 to 28 February 2026, including:*
- c. *Parking fees from meters*
- d. *Parking fines for over time*
- e. *Parking fines for not paying*
- f. *Monthly breakdown*

Answer:

In response to the first part of your request, the total annual rates assessed for properties on the section of Jackson Street between Cuba Street and Hutt Road for the 2025/2026 rating year is approximately \$3.98 million. This information is derived from Council's property data, which is publicly available through Council's Open Data portal at: [Hutt City Property Boundaries | Hutt City Council Open Data](#).

The parking revenue information for Jackson Street and the Peel Street Car Park for the period 1 October 2025 to 28 February 2026 is set out in **Table 1** below.

When considering the data presented in this table, it is important to note that parking meter revenue reflects physical parking meters only and does not include PayMyPark transactions, as PayMyPark payments are recorded at a broader parking zone level and cannot be reliably attributed to individual streets.

In addition, infringement figures reflect fines that were issued during the relevant period and do not indicate whether those infringements have subsequently been paid. You will also note that the figures for December 2025 are recorded as zero, as free parking was in place across Petone for the entirety of that month.
