

Kia ora Andrea and Frances,

I am writing this email to you on behalf of my staff who, like me, are disturbed Council is censoring information that is held in our hubs in the process of delivering library services.

LIANZA, the professional voice of librarians in NZ, have a <u>statement</u> on censorship which I feel the need to show you. Yesterday my staff were asked by to remove an insert from the Hutt News that went against our professional roles as librarians. Local newspapers, like the Hutt News, are external publications we make available to our customers. We can't and should not control what's in the Hutt News.

Our role is to provide equitable access to information – unless it has been ruled illegal. Should we now also remove Mein Kampf from our collections? Should we stop providing internet access so customers can't go down rabbit holes and join QAnon? Where will it end?

Our mission as libraries is to be gateways to knowledge, rather than gatekeepers, supporting the intellectual freedom which is vital for both individual and societal development, innovation creativity, and the realisation of human rights.

Yesterday's actions did not align with our professional ethics and I would be reluctant to see my staff placed in that position again hence this email.
