- What is the Hutt City Council paying Sustainable Coastlines for the monthly exercise of a beach clean-up and auditing the rubbish from a section of the western end of Petone Beach?

The contract is \$1900 per month for the beach clean-up and \$3900 per month for the litter monitoring and auditing. These costs are GST exclusive.

This work is part of the nationwide litter intelligence programme, which follows the government-endorsed methodology for monitoring litter throughout New Zealand. As all regions apply the same methodology, the information collected from our region can be compared and compiled with that of other regions.
