## Request for Information – Local Government Official Information and Meetings Act (the Act) 1987

We refer to your request of 21 May 2024 for Information regarding the Rebel Business School. We will answer each of your questions in turn.

• Total given to "The Rebel Business School" by your organisation and or CCO'S broken down by year.

In the Financial Year 2020/21 - \$11,319.45+GST (in its previous form known as "Pop-Up Business School").

In the Financial Year 2022/23 - \$14,000.00+GST.

•The reasoning behind your organisation beginning these deals.

Hutt City Council supported several business start-up initiatives at the time recognising the impact that small businesses can make to the economic wellbeing of our communities. We sought a variety of localised programmes to assist local entrepreneurs on their small business journey.

•Total citizen completed certificated since beginning funding this program - Please add how many courses have been funded and their dates.

There were two courses, in September 2020 and September 2022. There is no formal record retained of participation / completion in these courses.

•Have issues been raised on the attendance - such as not attending the whole course but still getting a certificate.

No issues have been raised regarding this.
