Request for Information – Local Government Official Information and Meetings Act (LGOIMA) 1987

We refer to your official information request dated 12 March 2025 for:

- 1. The cost of installing sensors at the Kelson School Crossing, Major Drive
- 2. Date of install and cost to Hutt City ratepayers
- 3. A copy of the community consultation results from Kelson Crossing survey run by Hutt City Council
- 4. Of the \$220,000 spent on the Kelson Crossing, how much did Waka Kotahi contribute

Answer:

1. Cost of Installing Sensors


The cost of installing sensors and cameras at the Kelson School Crossing was circa \$11,351.40 (exl GST).

2. Installation Date and Cost to Hutt City Ratepayers

The sensors were installed on 6 March, with monitoring continuing through the end of March.
