From the opening year of the Ricoh sport Centre to when they left running the Ricoh Sport Centre in Lower Hutt."

Answer:

Funding provided to Fraser Park Sportsville by Hutt City Council from the opening year of the Ricoh sport Centre to when the lease ended in September 2024 as follows:
