Request for Information – Local Government Official Information and Meetings Act (the Act) 1987

We refer to your email dated 2 July 2024 for:

Could I please request the following information under the OIA:

- (i) What was your council spend on emergency management capability, and how many staff members did you have within emergency management roles, for the previous 3 financial years (1 July 2021 30 June 2022, 1 July 2022- 30 June 2023, 1 July 2023- 30 June 2024)
- (ii) How much is your council budgeting to spend on emergency management capability, and how many staff members will you have within emergency management roles, for the current financial year (1 July 2024- 30 June 2025)

The table below provides details of the Council's actual expenditure and budgeted expenditure, and employee numbers with emergency management roles, for the years that have been requested. Actuals for 2023/24 are provisional.
