Thank you for your information request of 28 October 2022, to Greater Wellington Regional Council, in which you ask about the likely impact of the Self-contained Motor Vehicles Legislation Bill on the Freedom Camping Act 2011. Greater Wellington Regional Council has transferred your information request to Hutt City Council for its response.

I advise that Hutt City Council does not have a freedom camping bylaw. If amendments to the Freedom Camping Act are passed, Hutt City Council will consider the requirements of those amendments, at that time, including how to apply, monitor and enforce any new requirements.

You have asked in your 7th bullet point if the Council met MBIE's 3 October 2022 deadline for transitional funding applications. Hutt City Council did not submit an application for transitional funding.

At this current time, Hutt City Council does not hold any further information that is relevant to your information request.
