Tēnā koe Jing,

Request for Information – Local Government Official Information and Meetings Act (LGOIMA) 1987

We refer to your official information request dated 13 January 2026, seeking information about the notification of a speed limit certificate and the installation of 30km speed limit signs on Britannia Street, Petone. Specifically, you requested:

- 1. The certificate ID OU215ZRQCD states a start date of 08 Jan 2024. Can you please advise how and when this certificate was notified to the general public?*
- 2. Can you please advise when the 30km speed limit signs were installed, and if there was any notice given to the general public when they were installed.*

Answer:

Council did not issue a public notice about certificate ID OU215ZRQCD when the change in speed limits on Britannia Street was approved. The change formed part of a wider programme of speed limit reviews considered by Council's Infrastructure and Regulatory Committee in March 2023 (Report number [IARCC2023/1/30](#)), and the Committee's recommendations were subsequently adopted by Council.

Consultation for the proposed changes that led to the creating of certificate OU215ZRQCD was undertaken with schools and residents from 5 December 2022 to 15 February 2023, but the Land Transport Rule: Setting of Speed Limits 2022 does not require public notification after formal approval, and no further communication was undertaken at that time.

Regarding the installation of the 30 kilometre per hour speed limit signs, these were installed on Britannia Street on 31 January 2024. Council did not issue a public notice about the installation of these signs, although the changes were published on our website at the time.
