The demolition costs are recorded as operational costs, whilst the balance of the costs is recorded as capital expenditure.

Council approved both opex and capex budgets for this project as part of the LTP 2021-2031. The demolition budget was approved on 24 September 2020 at the LTP Subcommittee meeting (Refer page 51) at \$1.5M and the capex budget approved was \$68M.
