Request for Information – Local Government Official Information and Meetings Act (LGOIMA) 1987

We refer to your official information request dated 9 March 2026, seeking information on the costs of collecting parking revenue on Jackson Street. In response to your questions about this matter, you asked:

- A. *A: Please provide the costs of collecting parking revenue (meter fees, over time and non-payment fines) in Jackson Street from 1 October 2024 to 30 September 2025.*
- B. *B: Please provide the costs of collecting parking revenue (meter fees, over time and non-payment fines) in Jackson Street from 1 October 2025 to 28 February 2026.*

Answer:

Council does not record parking-related expenditure, including staff time, parking meter costs, or costs associated with overtime or non-payment infringements, at the level of individual streets, locations, or suburbs. This information is not held in a form that would allow costs to be attributed specifically to Jackson Street for the periods you have requested.

While the LGOIMA provides a right of access to official information that is held, it does not require Council to create new information or undertake new analysis or

reporting in order to respond to a request. Providing the information sought would require Council to do so.

We are therefore refusing your request under section 17(g) of the LGOIMA because the information requested is not held in the way you have requested it.
